## **PrestoSpace Preservation Factory Workshop**

18 May 2006 - Hosted by ORF, Vienna, Austria

For two years, the PrestoSpace project has been promoting concept of a *preservation factory* as a better way to preserve Europe's audiovisual heritage.

**But, what exactly is a Preservation Factory?** This workshop will provide the answers to that question, and also have presentations on:

- How to set up and run a Preservation Factory
- How to deal with archives
- What archives want

- commercial organisations already involved in archive digitisation work
- equipment developers and manufacturers
